



Net Zero Policy

Sydney Desalination Plant Pty Limited (SDP) is committed to minimising our environmental footprint while providing a secure supply of high-quality drinking water to Greater Sydney.

We are proud to have achieved an 100 per cent offset of our emissions for the energy used to produce drinking water by buying 100 per cent renewable energy certificates and a small number of carbon offset certificates for low carbon emitting activities undertaken on our site at Kurnell.

Our focus is now building on this success by reducing our Scope 3 emissions as we strive towards becoming a leading, sustainable producer of desalinated drinking water, with an objective of achieving net zero status by 2030.

We are developing a plan to cover our organisational supply chain, which we will align to the Climate Active Net Zero Standard.

Our initiatives to meet our net zero target include:

- implementing, maintaining, and communicating this policy across the organisation and making it available to our customers and all key third party suppliers.
- continue to procure renewable energy for all electricity used in the process of drinking water production to supply to our customers.
- continue to actively participate in global benchmarked Environmental, Social, and Governance infrastructure assessments such as GRESB.
- reduction and/or elimination of emissions where technically and commercially practicable within the other legislative and contractual obligations for the organisation.
- investment in appropriate resources, innovative solutions, new technologies and data analytics.
- empowering our staff to implement carbon net zero solutions at work and at home.
- measurement, monitoring, analysis, and reporting of our carbon emissions on an annual basis (including scopes 1, 2 and 3) to ensure we are continually challenging ourselves to meet our targets
- collaborating with our key third party suppliers to reduce supply chain related emissions through measurement, target setting and reporting, and factoring these into procurement decisions.
